"FUN RUNS" (PRACTICE RUNS) \$5.00 (Run in the last hour each day)

ROLL CALL:

Roll call is the time when participants are expected to check in by. Check-in will open at the time each block is scheduled to run (e.g., 10-11am block open at 10:00). Check-in is followed by inspection for fitness, lameness, and "in season" females. DOGS MUST BE INSPECTED BEFORE EACH RUN.

TEST HOURS: Friday/Saturday 8:00am-3:00pm Eastern Time. Sunday: 8:00am-2pm. Check-in closes at 1:00pm on the last day.

A lunch break may be taken between 12:00-1:00pm each day, no lunch break on the last day.

Fast CAT will be divided into one-hour time blocks with concurrent tests. We will do our best to accommodate requests, but preferred time blocks are not guaranteed. If all blocks fill, more time slots may be added to accommodate additional entries. Workers / volunteers may run their dogs prior to the first morning block, or their dogs may be added in during the day.

CAMPING RULES & REGULATIONS

Speedway Classic of the Carolinas Parking is solely at the applicant's own risk. The applicant by submitting this application waives any and all claims and cause of action against the clubs and the Cabarrus Arena & Events Center and their employees, agents and volunteers related to loss of, or damage to the vehicle or its contents, including all claims and causes of action arising out of the negligence of such parties. The applicant agrees to indemnify the clubs and the Cabarrus Arena & Events Center, their employees, agents, and volunteers for any and all loss by fire, theft or damage, or loss of personal property, or the loss or injury to the animals in the applicant's charge while on the event grounds or parking area.

1. NO REFUNDS - NO EXCEPTIONS after March 11, 2020
2. 2. Camping sites are at the discretion of the RV Committee.
3. All payments must be received with reservations.
4. Assignments of space will be at the discretion of RV Parking Committee.
5. With full hookups, center Hookups will provide electric, water hookup and dumps where/ when available. Dump station will be available. You must bring appropriate power cable, adaptors, and water hose, 100 feet suggested.
6. Vehicle and camping equipment must not extend beyond assigned space.
7. No reserving/saving of spots for other campers.
8. All motorized vehicles must have a valid state license plate.
9. No charge for tow vehicle.
10. No unauthorized golf carts, motorized bikes, skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, scooters, etc., are permitted on site.
11. Camping is permitted in designated campgrounds only.
12. Excessive drunkenness or lewd behavior will not be tolerated.
13. No ground fires, fire rings, or open flame grills.
14. No firearms, dangerous weapons or fireworks permitted.
15. No soliciting or commercial sales permitted.
16. Parking pass must be affixed to the front right side/windshield and be visible at all times.
17. Pets are welcome at our camping facilities if they are leashed, cleaned up after and do not disturb the other guests. Pets are not allowed inside the arena restrooms (no exceptions).
18. No loud or boisterous activity after 11:00 P.M. until 6:00 A.M.
19. Please be aware of all carbon monoxide dangers that can be harmful to you or other guests.
20. Vehicle and generator exhaust MUST be expelled safely into roadways and not into adjacent campsites.
21. Please place trash in receptacles or dumpster provided by Cabarrus Arena & Events Center.
22. All exhibitors and guests will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their spaces or will be asked to vacate their space immediately.
23. No tent camping allowed.
24. No shower or restroom facilities.
25. No outside catering.
26. No alcoholic beverages allowed outside RV/Camper.

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR HANDLERS

- If revisions to the premium are necessary, the most up-to-date version can be found on www.greatermonroekc.org
- You will be expected to have complete info for your dog. Incomplete entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- Battery-powered or gas-powered continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic. Electronic timing system will be used, with manual timing as a backup if needed.
- The Fast CAT running lane will be enclosed with temporary fencing, including the catch pen which will be at least 50 yards long. It is strongly recommended that prior to running your dog, you have a good "recall" control, as the dogs will be off leash.
- Handlers are advised to warm up their dogs prior to their run and walk them for 5-10 minutes afterwards.
- Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the huntmaster or when the lure begins to move forward. The huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve their dog.
- Handlers are not allowed to walk down the course before an official run.
- It is recommended that handlers have someone familiar with the dog at the end of the course to catch the dog or have someone else release their dog at the start line. Handlers are expected to promptly secure the dog and leave the field with the dog on leash.
- Recalls back to the start line are not allowed. Handlers are allowed to call the dog from the catch area. Toys or treats may be used to help catch the dog but must be concealed until the dog crosses the finish line.
- A \$5.00 fine may be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have their appropriate vaccinations.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be always under control of their parents or guardian(s) at all times.
- Females in season or lame dogs will be excused, and entries will be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the club or its members and representatives.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK. The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., and Greater Monroe Kennel Club, assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property before, during, or after this event.

FAST CAT BASICS:

Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards where a dog chases a lure. Dogs are run singularly and earn points based on their handicapped speed. Titles are issued at designated benchmarks. The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into speed in miles per hour. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned.

The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
- Under 12" = handicap is 2

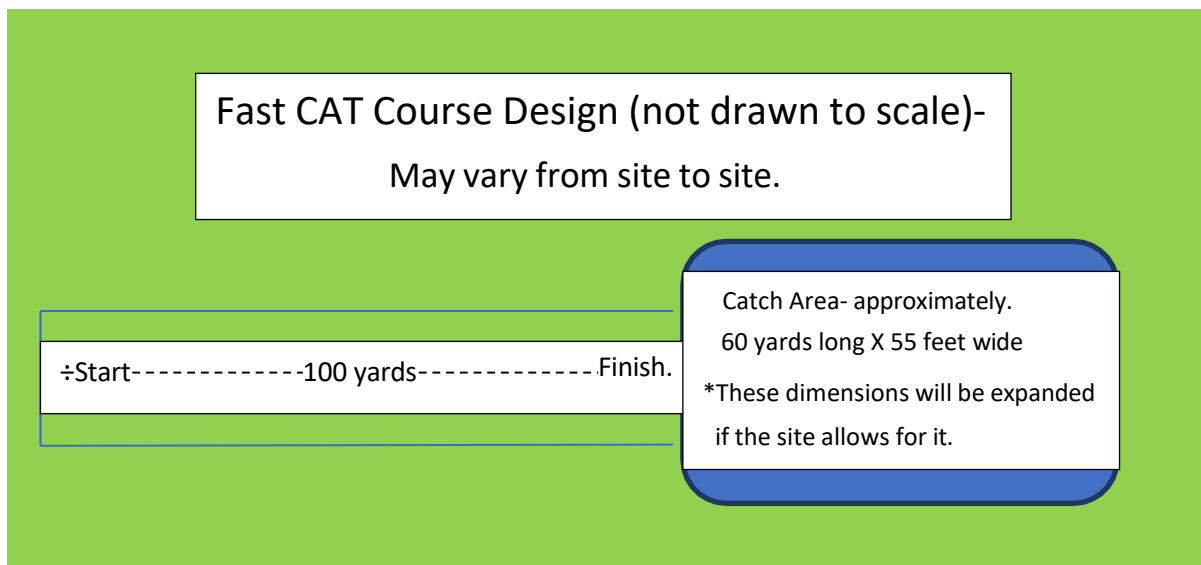
$204.545 \div \text{time (seconds)} = \text{speed (miles per hour)}$

Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: BCAT (150 points), DCAT (500 points), FCAT (1,000 points), and FCAT# (every additional 500 points)
